The 'regulation 14' pre-submission draft consultation took place between 13 November 2024 and 6 January 2025; this was further extended for statutory consultees until 17 January.

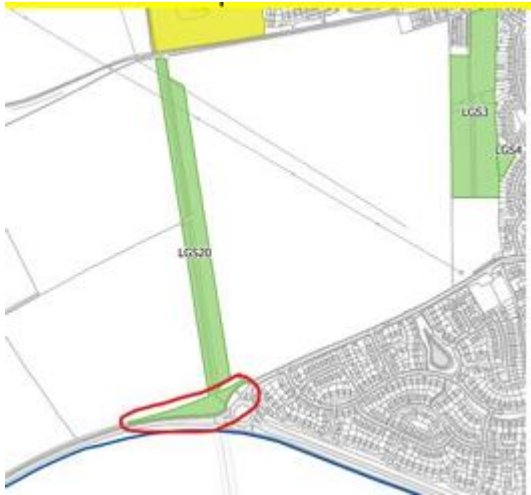
The Planning Consultant has now had opportunity to review the feedback and provided a summary with suggested amendments and items the Council may further wish to consider, this is attached as Appendix 1.
