The Environmental Committee request an additional £24K be approved by the Council for the Partnership Services budget 2025/26.

Risk Analysis

A budget and precept must be set for the next financial year to ensure the finance available for services. The Council agreed its budget for 2025/26 on the 9 January 2025, based on information known at that time. Since then, revised costs have been received from Northumberland County Council (NCC), which require an increased budget in order to achieve the Council's objectives. Adequate reserves are available to finance this request.

Crime Prevention

This does not impact crime prevention.

Objective

To promote good governance of the Town Council by adopting transparent practices and promoting public participation.

Report

The preparation of the Environment Committee budget for 2025/26 was based upon the estimate of costs provided by NCC to achieve the new

agreement between the 2 Councils. Since then, final figures have been received which require an additional budget of £24k.

The Council's reserves can meet this request as given below.

Note the level of reserves, include earmarked reserves, and therefore usable reserves are much lower as previously discussed at the January Council.

The earmarked reserves include those set for a Council of this size of \pounds 400k and for asset replacement re self-insurance of \pounds 330k.

With these in mind, the useable reserves are in the area of ± 95 k, which is the smallest variance between the "years" included in the financial model to 2030/31.
