Blyth Town Council have been approached by the Northeast Ambulance Service and Northumberland County Council to take on the management of the defibrillator that is on the Broadway Pavilion. The system that is in place was donated by a resident from Blyth to NCC, and is the same model that we currently have in our other cabinets located around the Town.
