The Deputy Town Clerk provided a timeline based on experience in a neighbouring town.</p> <p>A member requested the planning consultant be asked what happens if the residents object during the consultation.</p> <p>A members noted a reference to the Bebside to town centre walking/cycling corridor; this should be omitted as the Town Council do not support this.</p> <p>It was resolved to agree the draft neighbourhood plan for consultation with the omission of the Bebside to Town Centre. The consultation should be publicised as much as possible to encourage community participation.</p>
